## BYLAWS OF THE "NICOLA ROMEO CLASSIC" CLUB

### Art. 1 Name

The name of the organization is the "Nicola Romeo Classic" Club, established as a free, non-profit association.

### Art. 2 Purpose of the Association

The Association unites the owners and students of Alfa Romeo on an international basis and its purpose is to promote awareness, conservation and the use of such vehicles. For these purposes the association will organize meetings, rallies, publications and services of common interest.

### Art. 3 Co-Founders

Founding members are all those who are listed in the Articles of Incorporation of the Club.

### Art. 4 Committee

The Committee consists of the members listed in the Articles of the Club. Membership on the Committee is for life. As a result, during the Annual Meetings, no external application to the Committee will be considered. However, members may submit their resignation with justification. In this case the other members will appoint a replacement.

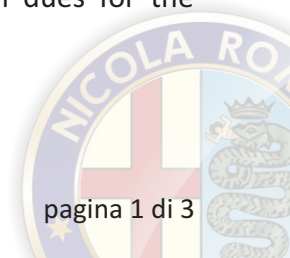
### Art. 5 Honorary President

The post of Honorary President is created as a moral inspiration for the Club. The Honorary President also acts as chairman of the meetings of the Committee and of representatives abroad. The charge is for life and is exempt from the payment of dues.

When the Bylaws were adopted, Daniela Maestri Romeo was elected to the post.

### Art. 6 Members

All the people affiliated with the Club, and consequently accepted by the Committee, are those who have paid social dues for the current year by the date established by these Articles.

#### **Art. 7 Honorary Members**

The Committee may appoint , as honorary members, distinguished persons connected with the history of Alfa Romeo models or who are particularly meritorious in the eyes of the Club. Honorary Membership status does not involve the payment of the membership fee.

#### **Art. 8 Senior Members**

Senior members are those who own an Alfa Romeo car that is at least 30 years old as tested (Switzerland) or equivalent certification (abroad). Aspiring members must apply by completely filling out the form on the Club's website. The Committee will communicate its decision on the application as soon as possible.

If accepted, senior members must remit CHF 200.-- (Switzerland) or the equivalent in foreign currency by the date specified in these Articles. Those who become delinquent after the deadline set by the Treasurer will be withdrawn from the list of members.

#### **Art. 9 Junior Membership**

Junior members are those who own an Alfa Romeo car that is less than 30 years old. Aspiring members must apply by completely filling out the form on the Club's website. The Committee will communicate its decision on the application as soon as possible.

If accepted, they must remit CHF 100.-- (Switzerland) or the equivalent in foreign currency by the date specified in these Articles. Those who become delinquent after the deadline set by the Treasurer will be withdrawn from the list of members.

#### **Art. 10 Member-Sympathizers**

Individuals who make a monetary contribution to the Club or whose various actions make a significant contribution to the Club may become member-sympathizers. Aspiring member-sympathizers must apply by completely filling out the form on the Club's website. The Committee will communicate its decision on the application as soon as possible.

**Art. 11 Sections foreign - contact**

The foreign representatives (one per country or homogeneous area affected by the presence of car collectors) are appointed by the Committee and are responsible for managing Article 2 of these Articles in their geographic area. They remain in office for three years and may be reappointed to office.

**Art. 12 Secretary - Treasurer**

The Secretary - Treasurer of the Club who participates in an advisory capacity to the Committee's decisions, shall be a trustworthy person of the Committee chosen by the founders. The Treasurer is responsible for the collection of dues, manages the assets of the Club and shall pay the expenditures approved by the Committee. The Treasurer is required to prepare a report in accordance with the administrative and fiscal rules which will be presented during the Annual Auditing Meeting .

**Art. 13 No charge assignments**

All the positions are taken by Club members on an honorary basis and may not give rise to compensation.

**Art. 14 Payment of dues**

January 31 is the deadline for payment of dues related to the current year.

**Art. 15 Income and assets**

The revenue of the Club shall consist of dues, donations, bequests, sponsorships and any contingent assets of the activities of the Club. In the event of dissolution of the Club any remaining assets will be donated to charity.
